## TRASH CURBSIDE COLLECTION

## TRASH, YARD WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION WILL REMAIN THE SAME DAY UNTIL FEBRUARY.

Trash is collected one (1) time per week and will be changed to Tuesday starting **FEBRUARY 6<sup>™</sup>**. Each household may set out up to 96 gallons of trash (bags or containers) per trash collection day. Place trash containers at the curb the evening before collection.

## RECYCLING COLLECTION

Recycling material will be collected one (1) time per week on Thursday. Place recycling containers at the curb the evening before collection. Refer to the next page to see a list of what is accepted as recycling including new flexible plastics.

## **BULK ITEM COLLECTION**

Bulk items will be collected same as trash day collection and will change to Tuesdays starting FEBRUARY 6™. Each household may put out one (1) bulk item a week. Bulk items are furniture, carpet (rolled and tied, maximum width 48"), construction and demolition debris (maximum length of 48"), washers, dryers, dishwashers. Mattresses and box springs must be bagged and sealed in plastic mattress bags when placed curbside. These plastic bags are available at hardware stores.
